The Clue of the Broken Locket Jacket To Debut

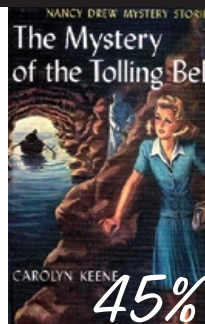
Considered one of the most unusual and rare entries in the series is Rudy Nappi's 1962 revision for *The Clue of the Broken Locket*. Only available in print as a yellow spine picture cover from 1962 to 1965, the art utilizes an eerie yellow color palette and allegedly casts Nappi himself as the crusty old man from the story. This art recently won our January web poll and will make its debut as a dust jacket for the first time in early spring.

Coming in April and May, dust jacket restorations of such classics as *The Mystery of the Ivory Charm* will be added, as well as prints for titles released only as picture cover hardbacks, including *The Invisible Intruder* and *Mystery of the Glowing Eye*. 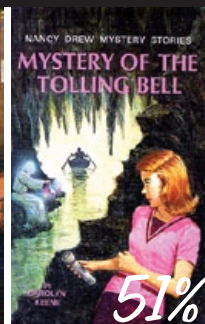
