## Tandy's *The Mystery of The Tolling Bell* Debuts

Here is the dust jacket that started the new modern look for the series in 1946, introducing both the wraparound jacket concept and the classic title style. This gorgeously restored jacket showcases the Bill Gillies spine emblem for collection consistency rather than the profile silhouette initially carried over from the white spine volumes, but is otherwise modeled after a 1949 jacket, lists to *The Ghost of Blackwood Hall* and features an advertisement for the Beverly Gray mystery series.

This summer will see the release of dust jackets for volumes only previously published as picture cover hardbacks, including *The Phantom of Pine Hill*, *The Clue in the Crossword* and *Mystery of the Glowing Eye*. These and several other new jacket designs will be offered for sneak preview purchases at our table at the Nancy Drew Sleuths convention on Saturday, June 16.
